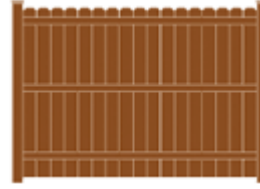
Composite fencing installs just like wood so it offers endless design options ranging from picture frame to scallop to full privacy.
