Re: <u>California Proposition 65 Declaration – Hazardous Substances</u>

Dear Valued Customer:

This letter shall respond to your inquiry regarding products manufactured by AZEK Building Products and whether any of them contain chemicals requiring a customer warning under the California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986. This Act, commonly known as Proposition 65 (Prop 65), establishes a list of chemicals which the state of California's risk assessment process has determined to present a risk of cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. Certain products made by AZEK do not contain chemicals which are listed on California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 or are otherwise present in an amount or manner which is exempt from the labeling requirement. These include TimberTech® AZEK® Capped Polymer Decking and AZEK® PVC Trim & Moulding products.

Other products made by AZEK Building Products, including TimberTech® Pro and TimberTech® Edge decking products, as well as TimberTech® wood plastic composite railing products, contain wood fibers. These products are made with a plastic (polyethylene)-wood composite which contains wood dust. When the TimberTech products are drilled, sawed or sanded, individuals may be exposed to wood dust.

The risk of exposure to wood dust depends on how often and under what circumstances you work with TimberTech products. To reduce your exposure, work in a well-ventilated area and with approved safety equipment, such as dust masks that are specially designed to filter out microscopic particles.



In compliance with California Proposition 65, we are providing the following warning concerning TimberTech products:

WARNING: Drilling, sawing, sanding or machining wood products generates wood dust and other substances known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. Avoid inhaling wood dust or use a dust mask or other safeguards for personal protection.

Be assured, AZEK Building Products will continue to monitor the Proposition 65 regulations for any new chemicals. AZEK will compare any newly listed chemicals with the raw materials in our finished products and communicate this information to our customers.
